Mark Mehaffey: Artist, Teacher and Author:

After 40 years of painting, content of work and technical abilities have constantly evolved. "It is through challenge that growth occurs. To be timid, safe, complacent or overly satisfied does not push the boundaries of creativity." Controlled spray painting, realistic and non-objective paintings in watercolor and acrylic have been explored. "Art is a dialog between the viewer and artist" and his hope is to open and maintain that dialog. Signature member of the NWS, the AWS, Transparent Watercolor Society of America - Signature Life member-Master Status, Watercolor West and the Rocky Mountain Watermedia Society, and signature life member of Louisiana Watercolor Society. He is featured in many publications, videos and books. Award winner in the Shanghai Zhujiajiao Watercolor Biennial 2010. This is the first time this award was opened to artists outside of China. Twenty-four American artists exhibited with a total of 230 paintings from around the world. This was to coincide with the 2010 World Expo in China.
