The Treasury report from Shirley Senko showed a beginning balance of \$2,527.41, an ending balance of \$2,538.06, and a total of \$3,018.63.

Janet Hall announced the theme for The Festival of the Arts will be "Grow with the Arts". Set-up will be Wednesday, April 30th in the afternoon. Time has yet to be decided.

Also, we're looking for how and where to establish our art gallery again for next spring. Oakland County has minigrants at their disposal, up to \$4,000, which Janet will submit our group for.

The awards for the VAAL show included Carl Mayer, who received 2nd place; Sue Mallick, who received 3rd place, Rosa Paulus and Ann Carlson who both received Honorable Mention. Congratulations to all on a job well done! Also, it is worthy to mention that Sue Mallick had sold 2 pieces at the Ann Arbor District Library.

Glenna Livingston brought up that the number of people getting newsletters mailed to them has increased and that needs to change to emails instead.

Joanne Leavy of Sunshine announced that Billy Thompson had surgery and a get-well card was sent out by Janet Hall. No details were given.

Darl Papple of Library Exhibits mentioned he has a sign-up sheet for the Costick Center Gallery. He also needs two more subs for the downtown library.
